Environmental Learning for Kids and our youth and family programs are excited to welcome you. We provide environmental education programs year-round to student's and their families.

An activity fee has been put in place to help distribute the cost of equipment, traveling, and educational supplies. **The fee is \$50 per child and \$25 for each additional child and/or one adult. Additional adults are welcome at no cost. This is a non-refundable annual fee.** ELK offers over 50 educational activities each year. All other funding comes from grants; the amount of grant money to provide these educational services is estimated at over \$1,500 per participant. Your activity fee ensures your children will have a quality educational experience. It also automatically enrolls your entire family into LEAF (Learning Environmental Activities for Families) - families are invited to participate in activities, such as camping, fishing, and stewardship projects. In addition you will receive our newsletter, Trail Mix and mailings to update you about upcoming special events.

Students are expected to attend at least one field trip per month if able. Students are asked to only join ELK if they truly want to learn about the environment, wildlife, fish, and camping.
